Playground:

Playground:

- 1H would like a climbing frame. They say there are a lot of leaves and rubbish on the playground
- 2P we like running in it
- 3B We want to go into the rainbow area during breaks. We also want more equipment
- 4R rubbish on the ground and the water fountains are dirty. We should be able to use the rainbow area and we want more equipment
- 5B we want to play in the Rainbow area and we want more equipment and better goals for football
