This is what all the families said

**Dining room:**

- 1M said it is loud
- 2C Make it nicer by decorating it and it is too noisy. We need more space. Cheese lettuce and tomato available for burgers please
- 3M chairs are uncomfortable and they would like boys and girls to sit separately
- 4Mc Can it be less noisy and more colourful. Play music
- 5T Sometimes the plates and knives are dirty. More variety of food
- 6M Bigger space, wider variety of food. Pack lunches in first and year groups to sit together

**Dining room:**

- We want more tables in the dining room
- 2K – some children don't like the taste of the food and sometimes they don't hear the bell for their class and have to go with another class
- 3S said it is very loud in there and the trays are too heavy
- 4P would like to listen to music in the dining room and have a menu with a visual aid. Sometimes there is too much food on the floor and we would really like circular tables so we could see our friends
- 5P Can a menu go on the website? Could there be more choice? There is a lot of pasta. Some of the tables aren't clean when we come into the hall and we are not allowed to swap tables. Sometimes there are crumbs in the water jugs
- 6W when it is our time to eat there is food everywhere and we have to squash into small spaces that are clean

**Dining room:**

- 1H say that it is too noisy and children drink from the jug. Can tables be allocated for each class
- 2P it is loud in there and this stops us enjoying our dinner
- 3B adults should help the children with the trays and we want a larger dining space
- 4R There is always food on the tables and the floors and seats are dirty. Too noisy and cups are used and then put back on the stack and not washed
- 5P we sometimes slip on food on the floor. Packed lunches should be able to sit with school dinners. Tables and seats covered in food when we sit down
- 6W floor is dirty and we step over food. Tables aren't cleaned and are flooded with water. Children pour water back into the jug from their cup. Not enough time to eat and the hall is being packed away while we are eating. Children throw food under the table they don't want. Too many year 6 to one bench
