
## The school day

 We are a nut-free school. Please do not put any food that contains nuts (e.g. peanut butter/Nutella), fizzy drinks etc in packed lunches






# Assessment for Learning

Year 2 children who didn't achieve the phonic screening pass mark in Year 1 will also take the screening check in June 2025 and will receive extra phonic support throughout Year 2




